The Army acknowledges receipt of Georgia Environmental Protection Division's (GA EPD) correspondence dated February 7, 2013 which provided us your organization's review of the <u>Final Compliance Status Report (CSR) Revision #1, HAA-01 (Former Fire Training Area and DAACG Chlorinated Solvents Area), HSI Site # 10395, Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia, dated April 2012.</u>

As you are aware, last year the Army Environmental Command (AEC) at Joint Base San Antonio, Texas directed the Installation to change the legal and regulatory driver for this site's clean-up from being undertaken in accordance with the Georgia Hazardous Site Response Act (HSRA) to being undertaken in accordance with the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA). Because of that decision, on May 23, 2012 a stop work order was issued on the contract supporting this site's clean-up. This action was necessary so the scope of work could be changed to comply with CERCLA requirements in lieu of HSRA requirements.

Because the clean-up of this site is now proceeding under CERCLA, the Army is asking GA EPD to withdraw the referenced CSR previously submitted under HSRA. The Army anticipates that no additional work will take place at this site for another 18 – 24 months or until such time as a new contact is awarded for the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) required under CERCLA.
