Fort Stewart is pleased to submit the *First Annual* Monitoring Only Report for former underground storage tanks (USTs) #2 and #3, Building 1840, Facility Identification Number 9-089065, Fort Stewart, Georgia. This report documents the semi-annual monitoring conducted in January and June of 2000, in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan-Part B that was submitted to GA EPD, USTMP in August 1999 and approved in correspondence dated January 25, 2000 (Logan to Perez).

Fort Stewart recommends that semiannual monitoring at this site be discontinued. The maximum detected benzene concentration in June 2000 was 0.92J ug/L, which is less than the site specific ACL and the fate and transport modeling predicted maximum concentration. Additionally, the site scored a 0 on the Site Ranking Form based on the June 2000 sampling event (see Appendix IV). Therefore, Fort Stewart respectfully requests this site be granted a "No Further Action Required" (NFAR) status
