
The Georgia Underground Storage Tank Management Program (USTMP) has received your submittal, dated October 28, 1999, that forwarded a properly certified amended Closure Report. The report was prepared by your personnel.

Based on the current requirements of the Georgia Underground Storage Tank Act, the Georgia Rules for Underground Storage Tank Management (GUST Rules) and the data submitted, the USTMP has determined that no further action is required for contamination resulting from the referenced release.

However, further corrective action may be required in the future if mandated through more stringent State or Federal statutory or regulatory changes. Additional measures may also be required if existing or future drinking water systems or surface water bodies within two miles of the site are impacted by any dissolved contamination resulting from this release, or if previously unidentified soil contamination, dissolved contamination or free product are identified as originating from this site.
