Fort Stewart is pleased to submit the Final Addendum to the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) - Part A for Fort Stewart's former Underground Storage Tanks #236 and #237, Building 4578, Facility Identification Number 9089062. The original CAP-Part A was submitted on May 16, 1997, and review comments from Georgia Environmental Protection Division (GA EPD) were received on July 30, 1997. Fort Stewart responded to GA EPD's comments in correspondence dated September 9, 1997. A synopsis of that response is provided below. These responses were approved in correspondence from GA EPD dated March 13, 1998 (White to Spears). This addendum incorporates all requested information as approved in that correspondence.

Per GA EPD's Comment #1, and as agreed during on-site discussions with GA EPD representatives on August 14, 1997, Fort Stewart installed two additional Hydropunch borings at the former UST #236 site (i.e., borings 55-07A and 55-08). At each boring location, one soil sample and one groundwater sample was Analytical results are provided in Appendix C of the collected. addendum. Please recall, during our August 1997 meeting, all parties agreed that no additional investigation was required at former UST #237 beyond collection of the requested data (assuming the data did not suggest an unforseen problem at the site).

Site specific geological information was obtained at the former UST #236 site and utilized in performing site specific fate and transport modeling. This information is presented in Appendix G of the addendum.

Based on the analytical results obtained during the sampling of this facility and the results of the fate and transport modeling, Fort Stewart respectively requests that Facility Identification Number 9089062 be assigned a "No Further Action Required" status. I appreciate your consideration of this finding based on the information provided in the enclosed CAP-Part A Addendum.
