
Dear Mr. Logan:

Fort Stewart is pleased to submit to the Georgia Environmental Protection Division the Final Work Plan for Interim Remedial Actions (IRAs) at Former Underground Storage Tanks (USTs) 208 and 209, Facility ID#9-089036, Building 275, Fort Stewart, Georgia, dated August 2011 for your review and approval.

This work plan provides site-specific and background information related to IRAs at the former USTs 208 and 209 site.
