
Dear Mr. Logan:

Fort Stewart is pleased to submit one copy of the Final Work Plan for Interim Removal Activities at [former] Underground Storage Tank [UST] 61, Facility Identification Number 9-089104, Building 1161, Fort Stewart, Georgia, dated July 2006, for your review and approval. This work plan describes the removal activities; the quantity and types of samples to be taken; sampling rationale and criteria; field investigation techniques and procedures; analytical requirements and methods; quality assurance and control requirements to be applied; and any site specific health and safety procedures.

The objectives for the scope of work for the former UST 61 site are to extract any free product via vacuum pump prior to removing monitoring well 22-07. Monitoring well 22-07 will be removed by excavating a 15 foot by 15 foot area surrounding this well to a depth of 15 feet or to the depth of groundwater, whichever is less. Soil samples will be collected from the four walls of the excavation and the excavation floor for chemical analysis. Oxygen Release Compound® (ORC®) will be applied to the excavation floor and the four side walls. A replacement well will be installed for monitoring well 22-07. Fort Stewart will resume semiannual sampling events at this site in the second quarter of fiscal year 2007.
