The Land Protection Branch of the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the *SWMU 39 Corrective Action Implementation Plan, Direct Support Maintenance Facility*; Fort Stewart, Georgia, dated September 26, 2018 and received October 1, 2018. It appears that Fort Stewart has adequately addressed EPD's August 7, 2018 comments by conducting additional sampling of selected monitoring wells to confirm the 2017 data, monitoring the Arsenic concentration trend in select monitoring wells, monitoring the undisturbed Light Non-Aqueous Phase Liquid (LNAPL) and employing the use of absorbent socks for LNAPL recovery. Therefore, the above referenced document is approved for implementation in accordance with the corrective action schedule described in Section 10 and corresponding Table 10-1.
