This Certificate of Completion and Monitoring Well Closure Certification report has been prepared on behalf of Mr. Randy Drummond of the Georgia Army National Guard for the above-referenced facility.

In a letter dated August 11, 2010, the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD), Underground Storage Tank (UST) Management Program issued a "no further action required" status to UST Release #14 at this facility in response to a UST Closure Report submitted in May 2010 regarding an underground oil/water separator (OWS) tank. The subject OWS UST was located at the Maintenance and Training Equipment Site (MATES) facility at the National Guard Training Center on Fort Stewart. EPD requested that a Completion Report and Certification be submitted that documents that the monitoring wells associated with the release have been properly abandoned.



On January 24, 2011, two observation wells (OW-1 and OW-2) that were installed to assess/monitor the release and three existing monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2 and MW-3) located in the vicinity of the former OWS UST were closed. The wells were closed by filling the wells with hydrated sodium bentonite and either removing the surface completion or sealing it with cement. The closure method meets Georgia Well Water Standards Act closure criteria. The well closure was performed under the direction of a Georgia registered Professional Geologist.

Attached are two figures that depict the location of the former OWS UST at the training center and the location of the five wells that were closed. Also attached are photographs showing each of the wells before and after closure.
