The Land Protection Branch of the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has reviewed the above referenced request letter for No Further Action (NFA) at Solid Waste Management Unit 26 (SWMU 26). Based on the conclusion presented in the 30<sup>th</sup> Corrective Action Plan Progress Report, dated May 16, 2022, EPD concurs with Fort Stewart's recommendation that results from the calendar year 2021 sampling event show the concentration levels of the contaminants of concern have been below the remediation goals for three consecutive years of sampling. Therefore, the remedial efforts for SWMU 26 are complete and No Further Action status is granted. Please note that Fort Stewart shall continue to maintain land use controls at the site in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan requirements. The status of SWMU 26 will be changed to "No Further Action" with the next modification or reissuance of Fort Stewart's Hazardous Waste Facility Permit No. HW045(s)-4.
