

- 2971 homes have been inspected, **631 remaining**.





Educational classes conducted as part of the 5-day Reintegration model or within the first 90 days of redeployment to enhance communication skills, decision making, and increased resiliency for redeploying Soldiers and Families.

- **Topics**

- Stress Management
- Conflict Resolution
- Goal Setting
- Communication
- Healthy Dating Relationships
- Building and Growing Healthy Relationships
- ❖ Topics can be adjusted based on Commander's intent and guidance

- **Example Categories**

- Single Parents
- Single Under 25
- Single Over 25
- Married 1-5 Years
- Married 5-10 Years
- Married 10+ Years

- **Coordination**

- Units provide space and AV capabilities.
- SMs and Families stay in established categories and rotate classrooms
- Facilitated by FAP Specialists, MFLCs, Chaplains, Behavioral Health
- Follow-up with Wellness Checks

Army Community Service

MFLC Wellness Checks

Wellness Checks contribute to individual readiness by ensuring mental, relational, psychological, and spiritual health and providing the opportunity for SMs to meet with Army Agencies recommended by MFLC provider.

- **Overview**

- Command can prioritize Soldiers based on unit established criteria
- Pre-deployments and post-deployments
- One-on-one session with MFLC counselor in private setting
- Confidential with no reporting requirements to leadership
 - ❖ Exception for Duty to Warn

- **Coordination**

- ACS has identified space to conduct Wellness Checks (FSGA)
- 4 Counselors conducting 45-minute sessions simultaneously:
 - ❖ 4 sessions in am + 4 sessions in pm = 32 total per day (example flow)
- Command will establish throughput based on training calendar
- Individual units responsible for having SMs present for scheduled times
- SMs will be provide with a referral sheet for additional services
 - ❖ Unit leadership responsible for ensuring appointments are scheduled
- Include unit Chaplains and Behavioral Health for support

Family Advocacy Program (clinical)

• **Responsibility: Family Readiness**

Key Tasks:

- Conduct clinical assessments and provide individual, group, couples, and family counseling services
- Prepare cases for the Incident Determination Committee (IDC)
- Coordinate with commanders and other helping agencies to improve family readiness
- Update FASOR/Army Central Registry

Takeaways and areas to improve:

- The bifurcation of the FAP entities likely results in communication and resourcing gaps
- Time spent on IDC decreases time for outreach and clinical care
- Confusion among Soldiers and leaders which FAP is which
- FAP Clinical still has a negative connotation among Soldiers

Recommendations:

- Battle rhythm sync meetings between the two FAPs
- Co-habitat the FAPs together
- Explore options to replace the IDC
