## **Registration for Respirator Fit Testing**

## **BASIC COURSE INFO:**

- 1. **Respirator Fit Testing** is provided on an as needed basis for FS/HAAF USAG employees (including BMM) **who have a requirement** to use respirators at their job. Fit Test verification memo is issued to the organization POC upon completion of Fit Testing; good for one year.
- 2. Other organizations (outside of FS/HAAF USAG) requesting Fit Testing, must have a current and approved Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on file with the Garrison Safety Office.
- 3. We ARE NOT allowed and DO NOT Fit Test contractors.

## **REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Personnel MUST be medically cleared prior to Fit Testing. Contact **Occupational Health** at **(571) 802-0405** for medical examination and clearance.
- 2. After acquiring medical clearance, **Organization POC** will complete the FIT TESTING REGISTRATION SHEET (found on GSO webpage):

- 3. **Organization POC** will email the FIT TESTING REGISTRATION SHEET with requestor's details (including the 5Ws), and a confirmation of medical clearance to the USAG Safety Office at <u>usarmy.stewart.usag.list.gso-all@army.mil</u>.
- 4. The USAG Safety Office will review the Registration Request and medical clearance(s), and will contact the Requesting/Organization POC to schedule the Fit Testing (if approved).
- Personnel MUST have their own (government issued) respirator. BEFORE ARRIVING, respirator should be assembled (including proper filters) and be ready for Fit Testing.
- 6. Generally, the Fit Testing takes about an hour (group size dependent), and includes basic fitting, maintenance instruction, and the Fit Testing.
