## Significant Aspects of the SMS

FSGA/HAAF's SMS has three focus areas, known as Significant Aspects: Water Use, Energy Use, and Land Use (emphasis on Solid Waste Reduction and Threatened & Endangered Species Management).

#### **How Can You Contribute?**

#### **Conserve Water and Energy:**

- Turn off water while washing dishes/brushing your teeth.
- Don't irrigate during the heat of the day.
- Turn lights/equipment off when not in use.
- · Use energy-efficient light bulbs.

**Recycle at Work and at Home:** Don't let your efforts go to waste. Keep trash and recyclables separate.

**Protect Threatened & Endangered Species (TES):** Be mindful of TES habitats and related restrictions when working in training areas.

Adhere to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs): Know and follow all SOPs associated with your job/activity.
