

## Shredded Paper/PII

Do you have unwanted personal documents with Personally Identifiable Information (PII) that you've been meaning to destroy? Take your PII to Fort Stewart's Recycling Processing Center. No appointment required. Positive security control will be maintained until the PII is destroyed.



## Blue Recycling Dumpsters/Polycarts

Throughout the Installation, blue recycling containers are provided to collect commingled recyclable materials. You will find the recycling dumpsters next to brown trash dumpsters. Place all paper products inside a separate plastic bag with the top securely tied before putting in the recycling container. Never put yard waste or hazardous materials in recycling containers. All commingled recyclables are processed by hand at the Fort Stewart Processing Center.

## Mandate to Recycle

In accordance with Executive Order 13693 and Sustainability Management System Command Policy Letter #25, Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield must maintain a minimum waste diversion rate of 50%.



To assist with meeting the mandate, the DPW Environmental Division operates a processing center to segregate commingled recyclable materials. This facility is located off Wilson Avenue on Kilpatrick Road in route to the Fort Stewart landfill. Additionally, blue recycling dumpsters are located throughout both Installations for the collection of commingled recyclable items.



## The Processing Center

Recyclable materials are dumped onto the tipping floor. A loader transfers the materials into a hopper that is connected to a conveyor system. The conveyor moves the recyclable materials up and through a sorting line, where recyclables are hand sorted and dropped into separate bins below. Later, the materials are baled and processed for sale.

# SUPPORT THE RECYCLING PROGRAM!

## The following materials can be recycled on post:

### PAPER ITEMS

Junk Mail/Office paper, newspaper, magazines (including inserts)

How to recycle:  
Place in clear plastic bags.



### CANS/ #1, #2 & #5 PLASTICS

Water bottles, milk jugs, cleaning product, spray bottles, food containers

How to recycle:  
Rinse food from all containers.



### ELECTRONICS / INK CARTRIDGES

Computers, printers, keyboards, telephones. No govt. equipment.

How to recycle:  
Bring items to the drop off centers

FS: Italy St. (Bldg. 1143)

HAAF: Wesley Ave. (Bldg. 727)



### CARDBOARD BOXES

Shoe boxes, food boxes, delivery boxes

How to recycle:  
Break down and flatten all cardboard boxes.
