At no time will Soldiers bring uniforms or uniform components that are faded or have holes, rips, tears, stains, dirty and/or missing pieces of the component.

Field uniform and boots (will get dirty) (IAW AR 670-1 and DA PAM 670-1) for tactical Physical fitness Belt and Boots. IAW AR 670-1 and DA PAM 670-1 JAN 2021. CAC MUST NOT EXPIRE WITHIN THE 22-DAY CYCLE. Packing list meets minimum requirements for BLC. You are authorized to bring additional items or items not listed. All Soldiers must bring a hard copy of their STP printed not greater than 10 days before BLC enrollment.
