SUBJECT: Garrison Policy Memorandum #24 – MWR Unit Activity Funds

- 1. Reference. AR 215-1, Morale, Welfare, and Recreation Activities and Nonappropriated Fund Instrumentalities, 24 September 2010.
- 2. Purpose. To establish policies for the administration and distribution of unit activities funds from the Installation Family, Morale and Welfare Recreation (FMWR) Fund at Fort Stewart/Hunter Army Airfield (FS/HAAF).
- 3. Applicability. This policy applies to all military units permanently assigned to FS and HAAF.
- 4. Policy. Funds must be used for the collective benefit of all Servicemembers in the unit. All unit members must have the opportunity to participate in the activity supported with unit funds.
 - a. Units are authorized \$5.00 per Servicemember per year.
- b. Funds are available on a fiscal year basis, October 1 through September 30. Unused or unclaimed funds expire on September 30 and may not be carried over to the next fiscal year.
 - c. Without exception, funds may only be used at FS/HAAF DFMWR operations.
- 5. Procedures for establishing unit accounts and requesting funds can be found on the MWR website: https://stewarthunter.armymwr.com/programs/unit-funds.
- 6. This policy will remain in effect until superseded or rescinded.
