SERNEC_ALL DISTRO LIST MEMBERSHIP TO BE **AUTOMATED**

The sernec_all@army.mil distribution list serves to disseminate information to all Southeast region personnel. However, it is a manual process usually placed on the RNEC division chiefs to add new users to the list and remove users who are no longer a part of the RNEC. The task to manually add/remove users is often overlooked and is just one more thing that people must remember to do. However, being a member of the distribution list is vital for receiving important information about the region (we know you don't want to miss any newsletters!).



The Information Operations V-Team is working a solution to automate the management of the distro. Members will be automatically added and removed to/from an A365 group, which will be a member of the distribution group itself. Users are managed based on their assigned division within the SharePoint Online master personnel list. Thus, it is vital for each member of the Southeast Region to be assigned to a V-Team and/or division. (You can check that you are assigned to a division by simply checking your PERSTAT entry and ensuring a division is listed under your name.) Note that users belonging to multiple divisions will be added to both division groups. This solution also allows for emailing all users within a specific division at one time using the respective A365 group email address.

Users may receive automated emails within the coming weeks stating that they've been added to a division A365 group. No action is required on the user's part. Information regarding group names and associated email addresses is to come.
