¹ IAW AR 55-46 Chapter 2-4: When a soldier is assigned to a dependent-restricted tour, the travel and transportation allowances for travel of family members are authorized from the old PDS to a designated place as follows—

(1) Any place in CONUS the soldier designates.

(2) Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, or any territory or possession of the United States if authorized or approved by the soldier's losing installation commander. (A DA Form 4187 through chain of command to 3d ID Commander requesting authorization/approval).

- ² IAW AR 55-46 Chapter 2-8: Soldiers who elect to serve an "unaccompanied" tour may choose to leave their family members at their current location. Alternatively, soldiers are authorized to move family members to a designated place other than the new PDS. However, reimbursement is limited to the cost of the move from the old PDS, to the new PDS. The designated place may be—
- (1) Any place in CONUS the soldier designates.

(3) Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, or any territory or possession of the United States if approved by the installation commander. (A DA Form 4187 through chain of command to 3d ID Commander requesting authorization/approval).
