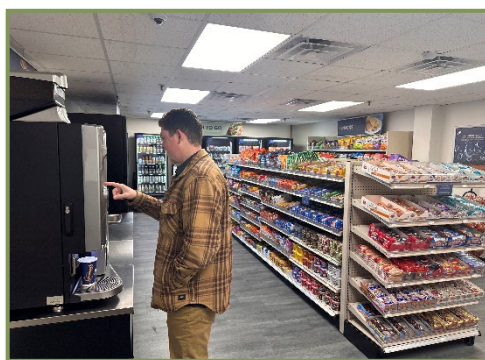

The new network enhancements expand the AFSBN area of operations by enabling the establishment of a [micro shoppette center](#) for its patrons. This initiative represents a forward modernization effort within the Joint Base Charleston footprint. The AAFES (Army & Air Force Exchange Service) Micro Markets Program introduces self-serve, 24/7 convenience stores strategically placed in both high-traffic and remote areas across military installations. These automated stores offer a broader selection than traditional vending machines, featuring fresh salads, fruit, sandwiches, and other grab-and-go items, including healthy choices aligned with the BE FIT 360 program. Customers can conveniently make purchases at a self-service kiosk or through a mobile app, providing flexible access for those working extended or non-traditional hours.
