*2 All uniforms and uniform components brought for wear and layout purposes must be clean and serviceable. At no time will Soldiers bring uniforms or uniform components that are faded or have holes, rips, tears, stains, dirty and/or missing pieces of the component.

*3 Field uniform and boots (IAW AR 670-1 and DA PAM 670-1) will get dirty for tactical physical fitness.

*4 Belt and Boots, IAW AR 670-1 and DA PAM 670-1.
