AUDS EXCEPTION GROUP

NASE users who have migrated to AUDS may be added to an exception group within Active Directory. The exception group will exempt users from being deleted from the NASE domain. This is needed, for example, when a user may want to use an MFD to Scan to Email where they must use their NASE account to log into the printer.

The root level of each Installation OU under the Southeast Region has an exception group. If you need to exempt your NASE account from being deleted in 7th SC's stale account query, simply submit a ServiceNow ticket to have it added to the applicable AUDS group "NASE GG SR [Installation] AUDS Migrated Users" (i.e., "NASE GG SR Stewart AUDS Migrated Users").

All general users' unclassified end-user devices should be migrated to AUDS by 1 June 2025. Find additional details in the EXORD here.

The RNEC has implemented a solution for IMOs' storage required PLA documets in wake of the sunset of ATCTS. The application mimics that of the **RNEC PLA Document Repository** previously put into place for NEC personnel.

- Personnel can only submit and access their own records.
- Personnel can review their own documents uploaded through the app.
- Personnel can delete their own records.
- The submitted documents are fully accessible by the Accounts Management V-Team.

PEO STRI MIGRATION EFFORT

Four members of the Southeast RNEC traveled to PEO-STRI in Orlando, Florida as part of a Proof of Concept visit.

During this visit, the goal was to show switches and workstations in PEO-STRI's SIPR environment could be successfully migrated to the Southeast Region's SIPR environment and bring them into compliance with STIG and CORA requirements.

The visit was a complete success with nearly half of PEO-STRI's SIPR environment being migrated to the Southeast Region. This included updating switches and TACLANES and re-imaging workstations. Many additional personnel who stayed back at Fort Stewart provided additional support such as creating user accounts and troubleshooting issues, for example.

A second visit is currently scheduled for early June to migrate the remainder of PEO-STRI's SIPR environment to bring them fully under the Southeast Region RNEC's SIPR ATO.
