### NEW! TOKEN APPOINTMENT APP



A new application has been developed for users to schedule appointments for token pickup and to provide visibility across the Account Management V-Team. Users only have access to their own appointments and may cancel as needed. Users must schedule a separate appointment for each token approved by Account Management and must provide corresponding AESMP ticket number associated with the token. An email reminder will also be sent before each appointment.

The application is currently piloted at Fort Stewart but is available region-wide upon request.
