MACRO ISSUE IN AUDS

ISSUE: AUDS does not have an exception for Office 365 Macros. Quite a few people use macros for various functions - the Budget department at Fort Novosel depends on macros for their applications to work, for example.

Before migrating to AUDS, users must ensure any macros they need for their daily functions are digitally signed to ensure they continue to work once they migrate to AUDS. AUDS will allow SIGNED macros, but if they are not signed, they will be blocked.



RESOLUTION: Developers must sign their macros. To sign a macro, you must first have a signing certificate.

For instructions on obtaining a signing certificate, view **section "4-18 Public Key Infrastructure code signing certificates"** (page 11) of the DA PAM 25-2-13 linked <u>HERE</u>.

Once a certificate is obtained, the macro/project can be signed by following the steps linked <u>HERE</u>.

FORT STEWART DA IG INSPECTION

The upcoming inspection at Fort Stewart RNEC, 7 – 10 April 2025, will assess the effectiveness of the Army's cybersecurity program across five functional areas and nine domains, contained within the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework version 1.0. The five areas include Detect, Identify, Protect, Recover, and Respond. Results of the inspection will serve as an indicator of how the organization is performing with FISMA compliance and will consist of personnel interviews and
