- Did you know... Now that the Data Tagging pilot has begun, all A365 users will see recommended sensitivity labels when working with documents, emails, and data. However, only pilot participants and MAM users (those under the Bring Your Own Device program) need to apply a label at this time.
- Did you know... Army Enterprise Azure Virtual Desktop (AVD) is a Windows 11 virtual machine that uses your Army 365 credentials for an optimized, full single-sign on experience. It is available from NIPR and commercial (including home) networks using government, corporate, and

personal devices, thus making it a great tool especially for TDY travel or telework.
