### **Trusted Traveler Policy**

Trusted Traveler Program: allows all DoD identification cardholders (DoD employees, active-duty military, family members ages 16 and older, and retired service members) to vouch for all occupants in their immediate vehicle.

- DoD ID Card Holder *MUST BE* the Driver
  - Unless Medical Condition prevents operation
     \*Being drunk is not a medical condition\*
- □ Trusted Traveler Operations- 0600-2100hrs Daily
- □ 100% ID Card Check Operations- 2100-0600hrs Daily
- □ Visitor Control Center Operations- 0600-1800hrs Daily
- DoD ID Card Holder under 16 cannot sponsor

#### 100% ID Card:

- DoD ID holder must be driver of vehicle
- All DoD ID, AIE, State DL/ID Cards Scanned
- Foreign Nationals w/ passports must be vetted via NCIC-III and TSDB prior to entry

#### Visitor Passes

- Kiosks located inside main gate VCC from 0600-1800.
- Visitor can obtain own pass from personnel at VCC.

Visitor registers using a generic pre-registration link or custom special event link.

Data submitted by the visitor is displayed on a secure web portal for Visitor Control Center (VCC) personnel to review prior to submitting for processing.

denial, the visitor receives a

custom text message to

contact the VCC.



VCC personnel submit visitor data for ID verification and background check processing.



The visitor can then go to the installation during the pass approval dates and use his/her DL for access or go to a kiosk and print off a pass.



If all checks return clear, the visitor receives a custom text message with pass approval notification, as well as pass start and end dates.



When the DL or pass is scanned at the installation for the first time, the scanning device reaches out to Iberon's servers to validate the pass and retrieves the visitor's registration information.

### Fort Stewart / Hunter AAF Military Police

- Vehicles not in deployment parking areas: Being towed as abandoned vehicles.
- Barracks room locks not repaired: Service members not locking room doors.
- On Post Housing: Secure your Doors.
- Secure Vehicles: Vehicles being left unsecure with keys/key fobs in them.

• **Insurance:** Georgia DMV requires drivers registering their vehicle with Georgia have insurance companies submit proof; Failing to do so will result in suspended registration.

• <u>**Registration**</u>: If vehicle and license is not registered in Soldier's home of record, Soldier must register their vehicle in Georgia within **30** days. Non-resident service/ family members stationed in Georgia are not required to obtain a Georgia driver license, as long as their home state documents remain valid and address with DMV is updated.

- <u>Window Tint:</u> In the State of Georgia your window tint can be no lower than 32 percent.
- <u>High dollar value sheets:</u> detailing property with description, value and serial number. This information is instrumental for reporting loss and increasing recovery.
- <u>Securing valuables:</u> (including TA50), utilizing locks on vehicles and barracks doors (CQ master key accountability) Do Not Store TA50, Valuables or firearms inside vehicles.

#### STEP 1 REPORT

SUBMIT A WORK ORDER: Call the maintenance call center at FS: 912-408-2466 HAAF: 912-459-2147 or online through the Resident Portal.

### ASSESS/SCHEDULE

Based on the work order priority (Emergency, Urgent or Routine), we will dispatch a maintenance technician or schedule a maintenance visit.

#### STEP 3 RESOLVE

Our maintenance team strives to complete all repairs in their initial visit. If it is necessary to order parts or work with a third-party vendor to resolve the issue, additional visits may be necessary and will be scheduled.

#### STEP 4 CLOSEOUT

Upon work order completion, residents will receive a text message notification from 844.991.0708 to confirm satisfaction with the work.

### STEP 5

Once the work order is closed in the system, you will receive an email asking you to complete an online satisfaction survey regarding your work order experience.





#### WORK ORDER STATUS - WHAT DO THEY MEAN??

- Schedule- work order is scheduled for a specific date and block of time. If work orders are placed via the portal, you will be notified via email what date/time it is set.
- In Progress- Work order has been started; technician has more work to do to finish the task
- **Vendor Assigned-** Work order has been assigned to a third-party contractor.
- **Parts Pending-** A required part needed to complete the work order was identified and ordered.
- **Tech Completed-** The work order has been completed by the maintenance technician- pending resident approval via key texting. If a No is marked work order returns to schedule status
- Work Completed- Work order has been reviewed and verified by service center coordinator
- **Canceled/Pending Cancelation** Work order has been canceled or is pending approval to be canceled (duplicate item- open work order already exists)

# **Work Order Process**

Work Order Closeout Text # FS: 912-937-9448 HAAF: 844.991.0708

- A technician visits your home and completes a work order. After updating notes, the work order is placed in TECH COMPLETED
- 8AM Local time the following day the first attempt to receive confirmation from resident that work is completed is sent to number identified as FIRST CONTACT
- 3 additional texts are sent in 12-hour increments in an effort to receive a response.
- If no response is received the work order is marked completed and notification is sent to the MHO office.
