

LOOKING FOR YOUR A365 GROUPS?



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If you're trying to find your A365 Groups, look no further than the lefthand side navigation pane in Outlook desktop or on the Web. You may have to scroll to the bottom of the navigation pane. Here, you can:

- View all A365 Groups that you are a member of (including your v-team group!)
- View group/v-team mailboxes
- Edit your group settings and membership (must be a group owner to edit group membership)


FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Why can't I upload to the "Files" tab in my V-Team Channel on Microsoft Teams?

A: Because it is best practice to store team documents in SharePoint Online, there is limited access to the Files tab in Teams (the Files tab is there by default and cannot be removed completely). However, all v-team members should have access to the "V-Team Documents" tab, in which the files are stored in the main RNEC SharePoint Online site on the backend (so even if the team or channel is deleted, documents stored here are NOT consequently deleted!). The v-team channel simply serves as an interface to easily access these files under the V-Team Documents tab. You can also access your V-Team Documents from your v-team page on SharePoint Online. Q: Whose status can I update on the new Regional PERSTAT app?

A: General users can edit their own status, as well as the status for members of their own v-team at their respective installation. Supervisors and leadership may edit the status of their respective subordinates.
