All students are required to have two complete sets of accoutrements for their ACU uniform; including Velcro unit patches, rank, nametapes, and U.S. Army tapes, along with subdued skill occupation badges (if applicable). The U.S. embroidered- colored insignia flag is the only authorized insignia. The U.S. Army name tape, rank, and special badges MAY be sewn on uniform as an alternative to Velcro insignias.

<b>* 2</b>	All uniforms and uniform components and boots brought for wear and layout purposes must be clean and serviceable. At no time will Soldiers bring uniforms or uniform components that are faded or have holes, rips, tears, stains, dirty and/or missing pieces of the component.	
<b>* 3</b>	Belt and Boots, must be brown.	
<b>* 4</b>	CAC MUST NOT EXPIRE WITHIN THE 22-DAY CYCLE.	
<b>* 5</b>	Unit authorized footwear is approved.	
<b>6</b>	Packing list meets <u>minimum</u> requirements for BLC. You are authorized to bring additional items or items not listed.	
<b>7</b>	All Soldiers must bring a hard copy of their ERB/SRB printed not greater than 10 days before BLC enrollment.	
<b>8</b>	All items must sustain you for 22 Days. Approved Medications Only.	
<b>* 9</b>	Linen will not be provided. It is highly encouraged to bring your own linen, pillow, and/or sleeping bag	
<b>10</b>	Encouraged to bring extra boots and ACUs. Will run PRT sessions through trails (with mud & water).
