# EVACUATION VOUCHERS

## Service Member Reimbursement:

Make sure that your profile to include your email address and banking information is correct in DTS.

Once the Authorization is approved you will receive an email that it has been approved. You will need to create a voucher to receive payment.

To create a voucher do the following:

Log into DTS - <https://dtsproweb.defensetravel.osd.mil/dts-app/pubsite/all/view/>

1. Click Create New Document on the Home Screen
2. Click Voucher
3. Screen will read create Voucher from Authorization – you need to pick the authorization for the Hurricane Evacuation and click create voucher
4. Click Continue at the bottom of the Review Page
5. Click Continue at the bottom of the Other Auths & Pre-Audit Page
6. Click Sign and Submit

NOTE: YOU ARE NOT to make any changes from the authorization to the voucher.

This will route the voucher to the approving official. Once the approving Official Approves the voucher you will receive an email that it has been approved and should receive payment within 5 days to your bank account that is loaded in DTS.

## Dependents/DAC Reimbursement

For Dependent Family Members and Department of the Army Civilians, ensure you put a good email address in block 6e on the DD Form 1351-2, Travel Voucher or Sub voucher. DFAS will send you an email when they receive your packet. This may take 7-10 days as DFAS is working on many travel reimbursement issues concurrently. Once received, payment should be made within 30 days. You will receive another email when packet is approved by DFAS and sent for payment. 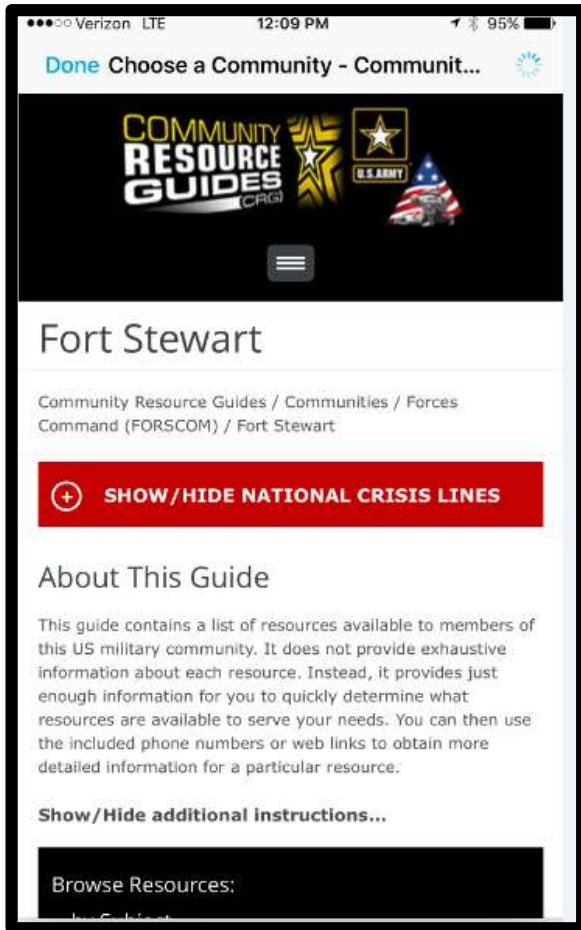

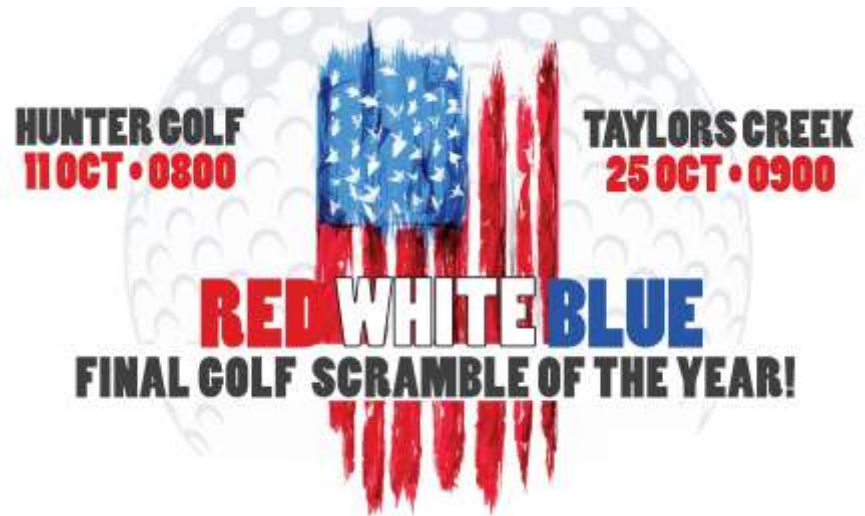
