MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: USAG-Stuttgart (USAG-S) Off-Post Uniform Policy

1. Purpose. This memorandum establishes off-post uniform wear policy for activities in the USAG-S area of operation (AO), as established in AE Command Memo 2020-019, Antiterrorism and Force Protection Guidance for USAG Stuttgart, 15 JUN 20. This AO generally includes the city and immediate surrounding areas of Stuttgart, Germany. This policy implements the provisions of USAEUR-AF OPORD 0020-21 (FY21-FY22 Baseline FP Posture).

2. Applicability. IAW AE Command Memo 2020-19, this policy applies to all military personnel under the Tactical Control for Force Protection (TACON for FP) of the USAG-S General Officer for Force Protection (GOFP), including personnel assigned to, performing temporary duty at, or present within the USAG-S AO.

3. Responsibility. All tenant leaders will ensure that service members strictly adhere to this policy.

4. Commanders will allow the wear of all United States Armed Forces service uniforms off U.S. or Host Nation (HN) installations, subject to the following circumstances when such uniform wear is prohibited:

a. At FPCON Charlie and Delta unless specifically excepted.

b. At off-post bars, night clubs, dance clubs, or any establishment with a primary purpose of serving alcoholic beverages. Service members, while in uniform and away from their residences, will only consume alcoholic beverages IAW USAG-S policies or with the approval of their supervisors (e.g., hail and farewells, dining ins, and other traditional military activities).

c. While traveling on public transportation (i.e., air, rail, bus, U-bahn, S-bahn) or at stations and stops. An exception is permitted to permit the immediate pick-up of passengers outside air terminals, stations, and stops.

d. Uniforms will not be worn by service members when traveling through or working in countries outside of Germany without prior approval from the country team (Office of the Defense Attaché) for that country.

5. Uniforms will be clean, serviceable, and worn IAW service standards.
6. Uniform wear policies are risk-informed and commanders will continuously assess the risk.
7. All personnel must report any harassment, suspicious activity, etc. to the Military Police, iReport or iWatch.
8. The provisions of paragraph 4 are punitive and offenders may be punished under the Uniform Code of Military Justice, Article 92.
9. The DCG-ARNG, USAREUR-AF, serving as USAG-S GOFP is the approval authority for off installation events with 300 or more DoD personnel regardless of uniform wear. Requests will be routed through the USAG-S AT office.
10. Unit commanders may impose additional limitations if necessary for the maintenance of good order and discipline or for force protection reasons. Any further limitations will be reported to the USAG-S AT office NLT 48 hours after commander action.
11. This policy is effective immediately and will remain in effect until suspended, revoked, or superseded.
