



Introducing e-CRBA

eCRBA is the Department of State's new online application for a Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA). eCRBA does not require any new information or processes – applicants enter the same information in eCRBA as in the paper application. This new application method, however, will allow you to enter your data, upload required documents, pay the CRBA fee and receive expedited processing. Additionally, you will be able to check the status of your application online.

Register for an account at MyTravelGov and create an eCRBA application

Pay the eCRBA fee. Your PPT Acceptance Agent will schedule a time to see both parent's and child, witness your signatures, and accept your original documents

In order to use e-CRBA you will need to provide your PPT Acceptance Agent's email address in your online application when it asks for Contact Information for Parents.
