MEMORANDUM FOR All Servicemembers, Civilian Employees and Family Members Working or Residing in the United States Army Garrison (USAG) Stuttgart Area of Responsibility

SUBJECT: USAG Stuttgart Command Policy # 45, On-Post Demonstrations and Similar Activities

1. References:

- a. Army Regulation 600-20, Army Command Policy
- b. Army in Europe and Africa Regulation 27-9, Misconduct by Civilians
- c. Army in Europe Regulation 55-46, Command Sponsorship and Travel Overseas
- d. Department of Defense Instruction 5200.08, Security of DoD Installations and Resources and the DoD Physical Security Review Board (PSRB)
- e. Department of Defense Instruction 1325.06, Handling Protest, Extremist, and Criminal Gang Activities Among Members of the Armed Forces

2. The purpose of this policy is to inform the USAG Stuttgart Community that on-post demonstrations and similar activities are prohibited. This policy applies to all personnel physically located on USAG Stuttgart military installations. Demonstrations or similar activities present a danger to the morale, safety, health and good order and discipline of the USAG Stuttgart military installations. Demonstrations or similar activities could materially interfere with the mission of USAG Stuttgart, and could present clear danger to the loyalty, discipline, and morale of Servicemembers.

3. Department of Defense Civilians, contract employees, and command sponsored Family members who violate this policy are subject to the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority which may result in loss of command sponsorship and early return of dependents.
