MEMORANDUM FOR All Service Members, Civilian Employees and Family Members of the United States Army Garrison (USAG) Stuttgart

SUBJECT: USAG Stuttgart Command Policy Letter #1, Commander's Open Door Policy

1.REFERENCE: AR 600-20, Army Command Policy, 24 July 2020.

- 2. Members of the USAG Stuttgart (Service Members, Civilians, and their Family Members) seeking assistance are encouraged to use their Chain of Command (military or civilian) and Non-Commissioned Officer (NCO) Support Channel to resolve their problems at the lowest possible level. However, this recommendation to use the Chain of Command should not be interpreted as a restriction against consulting the Commander, Deputy to the Commander, or Command Sergeant Major.
- 3. All personnel are free to approach the command team to discuss concerns during visits to your workplace, training locations, or during other Garrison activities.
- 4. If a problem arises during duty hours that does not require an immediate solution, arrange an appointment by calling my office at DSN 596-1300, CIV 09641-70-596-1300. Sometimes, a problem may be so pressing that it requires my immediate attention. In this case, personnel can contact me at my office, Building 2949 Room 214. During non-duty hours, utilize the Military Police Desk Sergeant (596-3102/3095) or the USAG Stuttgart Installation Operations Center (596-3742) to reach me.
- 5. I fully support the chain of command and will use it to resolve most concerns. For this reason, consider consulting your immediate chain of command first.
- 6. This letter will be permanently posted on all USAG Stuttgart unit bulletin boards.
