

**Mission:** Environmental Health provides Food Handler training to personnel desiring to serve food to the public on the installation.

**Intent:** Food handler training will provide personnel with proper food handling techniques IOT minimize health risks to the Fort Cavazos community and ensure compliance with health and safety regulations.

**End State:** Provide Fort Cavazos population and guests with safe food.

**Timeline:** Online Food Handler training is accessible throughout the year by following instructions below. Upon completion of the online training, trainees must submit a screen shot of successful test completion IOT to obtain certificate.

Face-to-face training is also available but requires a minimum of two weeks notice and availability is dependent on other EH mission requirements. Contact Environmental Health via email (see address below).

- Take a screen shot of your completion and send to Environmental Health via email to obtain your certificate.

**Face to Face Training**

- Minimum of 10 personnel required.
- The requesting unit will provide location and computer access.
- Instruction lasts one(1) hour.
- Certificates signed and given at conclusion of course.
