Finding of No Significant Impact for the Real Property Master Plan Programmatic Environmental Assessment

The Army announces the availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) for the Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) that analyzed the potential environmental impacts associated with implementing Fort Wainwright's Real Property Master Plan (RPMP). The FNSI presents the decision made by the Garrison Commander, US Army Garrison Fort Wainwright, Alaska, to implement the Army's preferred alternative to implement the Master Plan. The FNSI demonstrates that the Proposed Action would not significantly affect the environment and that an environmental impact statement is not needed.

The PEA and Draft FNSI were made available for a 30-day public review from March 13 – April 12, 2017. Responses to comments received and associated updates to the PEA can be found in Appendix A of the FNSI.
