SUBJECT: Energy Conservation (USAG Fort Wainwright Policy #14)

1. References:

- a. Executive Order 13834, "Efficient Federal Operations," 17 May 2018.
- b. Department of Defense Instruction 4170.11, Installation Energy Management, 11 December 2009, Incorporating Change 2, 31 August 2018.
- c. AR 420-1, Facilities Management, dated 12 February 2008/RAR 24 August 2012.
- 2. Consistent with the Army's Energy Strategy for Installations, U.S. Army Garrison Alaska will execute an energy management strategy to eliminate energy inefficiencies that waste natural and financial resources, and do so in a manner that does not adversely impact comfort and quality of the facilities in which Soldiers, Families, Civilians and contractors work and live. The key tenants of Fort Wainwright's program include:
- a. Designation of a Garrison Energy Manager to serve as the energy champion in all phases of planning and executing viable energy programs.
- b. Designation of Unit Energy Conservation Officers (UECOs) and Building Energy Monitors (BEMS) responsible for identifying building issues that compromise energy efficiency and retrieving and posting monthly energy reports for their assigned buildings.
- c. Execution of an energy training program to foster a sustainability approach and address current and future needs.
- d. Execution of an energy awards and recognition program to reward excellence in meeting our energy reduction goals.
- e. Refinement of our energy management systems and procedures to monitor our energy load.
- f. Ongoing analysis to determine energy consumption based on building type, area, and weather factors.

SUBJECT: Energy Conservation (USAG Fort Wainwright Policy #14)

- 3. This policy applies to all garrison directorates, tenant organizations, and military units assigned to Fort Wainwright. All commanders and civilian directors will designate a UECO/BEM in writing and provide a copy of that designation to the Garrison Energy Manager ((907) 361-6295 or (907) 388-0151).
- 4. Executing this energy efficiency strategy will enable USAG Fort Wainwright to counter our growing demand for energy and water and reduce our expenses in purchasing energy and operating our utility systems. We must take positive and sustained action to achieve the energy reduction goals identified in Executive Order 13834 and ensure the continued availability, quality, and security of energy and water for the installation.
- 5. This policy supersedes Garrison Policy #14, subject: Energy Conservation, dated 10 January 2020.
