On-Post Accommodations



Fort Wainwright on-post housing is owned and managed by North Haven Communities, a preferred choice for many active duty families and other eligible soldiers assigned to the Fort Wainwright military installation.

Off-Post Accommodations



Depending on the number of PCS rotations and size of the families departing, the wait for a home can vary widely at Fort Wainwright. Approximately one-third of the families assigned to the installation reside off-post for at least a portion of their tour-of-duty.

The DOD policy of raising BAH rates to eliminate most out-of-pocket expenses for rental housing has greatly improved the ability of service members of all ranks to obtain adequate, affordable, off-post housing.

For those who will be residing offpost, research and planning are essential for a successful move. Vacancy rates and rental costs off-post are seasonal. Rental units become more difficult to obtain and more expensive during the summer months as opposed to the winter months. Rent for houses is typically higher than that of apartments or duplexes.

Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA)

- Authorization for TLA starts the day you report for duty and sign into Fort Wainwright; You **MUST** be signed into the installation to qualify for TLA.
- Service members must be actively and aggressively seeking housing in accordance with the Financial Management Regulation (FMR) in order to qualify for TLA.
- TLA is not authorized during PTDY or during Transitional Leave.
- TLA may be stopped on the day that you decline the first available home for any reason other than a substantiated safety concern. If first home offer is declined prior to signing into the installation, TLA may not be authorized.
- Only hotel rooms are TLA approved; Vacation rentals / timeshares/ MWR cabins / and Bed and Breakfasts are not typically TLA approved. Campsites are normally reimbursable for MEALS ONLY (no lodging).
- Receipts will not be accepted through any 3rd party site including, but not limited to, Expedia.com, Hotels.com, Orbitz, Air B&B, Travelocity, etc.

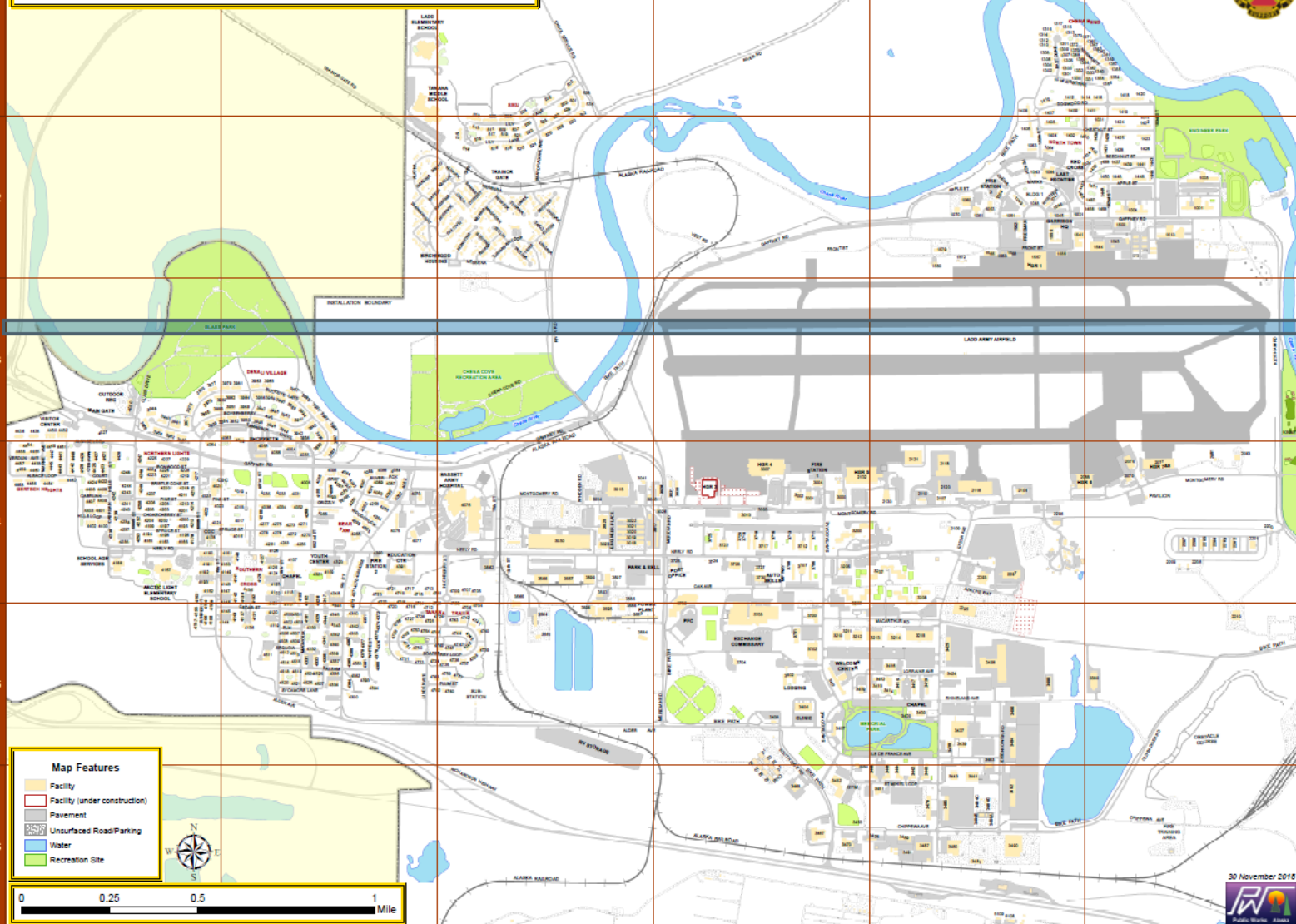

Pending school information provided by family, current SLO can provide Info Paper for new Army duty station and must provide Transition Checklist. If Youth Sponsor is requested, receiving SLO is to complete an email introduction to YC/ School Youth Sponsorship/ Ambassador Program POC. POC initiates YS Request form and process for youth sponsorship. Otherwise receiving SLO engages with family for school transition support.

Servicemembers Civil Relief Act

Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (SCRA)- The SCRA is a federal law designed to ensure that service members are not disadvantaged in their civil affairs because they have answered their nations call to military service. Service members (SM) can focus their full attention on their military responsibilities without adverse consequences for themselves or families.

***SCRA protections begin on the day the SM enters active duty military service. For military reservists, protections begin upon receipt of certain military orders.**

Who is covered by the SCRA?

- All persons on active duty in the uniformed services, including regular and active reserve.
- Reserve and National Guard personnel who have been active and are on Federal active duty.
- Reserve components who have received orders to report from the date of receipt of orders through the date of reporting for military service and beyond while on active military status.

SCRA does NOT apply to:

- Reserve or National Guard Units NOT on active duty
- Retired Personnel
- National Guard troops called to duty under State orders



What can the SCRA do for you?

Residential Lease can be terminated under the following conditions:

- Permanent change of station (PCS) orders
- Orders to deploy or TDY in excess of 90 days
- Discharge, resignation, or separation from the service under honorable conditions
- Retirement
- Temporary disability retirement

Effective Date of Lease Termination:

The lease ends 30 calendar days after the next payment is due.

Tenant Notice to Terminate:

- The notice must be in writing
- Express an intent to terminate the lease
- Delivered to the landlord or his agent
- Include a copy of military orders proving intent to terminate the lease or a verification (usually a letter) from the SM commanding officer verifying orders

**There is no statutory requirement to cite the SCRA as legal justification for lease termination or to indicate a specific date of vacating.

**A letter or email from the tenant to the landlord indicating a desire to terminate the lease due to the receipt of PCS or deployment orders, and attaching the requisite proof of military orders, satisfies the requirements of the statute.

Lease termination rights of SM's dependents

The SCRA provides that the term “dependent” includes the SM’s spouse, the SM’s children [as defined at 38 U.S.C. 101(4)], and any person for whom the SM provided more than one half of the individual’s support for 180 days immediately preceding an application for the exercise of SCRA rights [50 U.S.C.3911(4)].

Dependent lease obligations are terminated only as to the lease terminated by the SM. The SCRA does not terminate lease obligations of dependents who execute a lease independent of the SM.
