**Finding of No Significant Impact for the  
Bailey Bridge Replacement Environmental Assessment**

The U.S. Army Garrison Alaska announces the availability of a Finding of No Significant Impact (FNSI) for the Environmental Assessment (EA) that analyzed the potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed Fort Wainwright Bailey Bridge Replacement project. The FNSI represents the decision made by the Garrison Commander, U.S. Army Garrison Alaska, to implement the Army's preferred alternative to replace the existing Bailey Bridge with a new single-lane bridge in its place. The FNSI demonstrates that the Proposed Action would not significantly affect the environment and that an Environmental Impact Statement is not needed.

The EA and Draft FNSI were made available for a 30-day public review from July 26 – August 24, 2019. Responses to comments received can be found in Appendix A of the FNSI. The FNSI and EA can be viewed at:
