WHEREAS, the Agreement was executed on 29 June 2021; and

WHEREAS, the National Science Foundation (NSF) proposes to fund the excavation of Niidhaayh Na' archaeological site (XBD-00110) (OPP-2236813); and

WHEREAS, the National Science Foundation (NSF) requests to be an Invited Signatory to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, additional time is needed to implement the terms of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Garrison Alaska (USAG Alaska) will send a copy of this executed amendment to the ACHP; and

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation VIII, AMENDMENT, of the Agreement, USAG Alaska and the State Historic Preservation Officer agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation XI. DURATION so it reads as follows:

This MOA will become effective upon the execution by the signatories and will remain in effect until terminated or 29 June 2029. If all stipulations are not completed prior to such time, USAG Alaska may consult with the signatories to reconsider the terms of the MOA and amend it in accordance with Stipulation VIII.

2. Add Stipulation EXECUTION IN COUNTERPARTS:

This MOA may be executed in counterparts, with a separate page for each Signatory and Invited Signatory.

3. Add individual signature pages for each signatory and invited signatory.


