Domestic Violence Awareness Month Proclamation Signing

Domestic Violence Awareness Month (DVAM) is recognized in October of each year.

It is a time to raise greater awareness of resources for Soldiers, Family members, and Army Civilians who may need support or to help someone they know. The Army remains committed to fostering an environment of dignity and respect, where seeking help is a sign of strength, and where every individual plays a role in preventing domestic violence and supporting those impacted by it.

This year, the Army's DVAM awareness and prevention outreach efforts feature two distinct campaigns: "What's Inside Matters" and "Pause: Your Actions Matter".

"What's Inside Matters" focuses on victim awareness and ensuring survivors know they are valued, supported, and never alone, with resources available through the Family Advocacy Program, Military OneSource, Forensic Healthcare Program, National Domestic Violence Hotline, and other vital services.

"Pause: Your Actions Matter" encourages individuals who may be concerned about their own potentially harmful behavior to take a moment to pause, reflect, and seek help before harm occurs, promoting a culture of accountability and care within the Army community.

We call upon all of the West Point community and partners, our faith-based groups, law enforcement, schools, medical groups, and social services to join us in our effort to support our Service Members and Families, thereby preventing domestic abuse and family maltreatment, upholding Army Values, strengthening our military families, and fostering a safe and thriving community for all.





DPW – Projected Road Closures 30-Day Outlook




