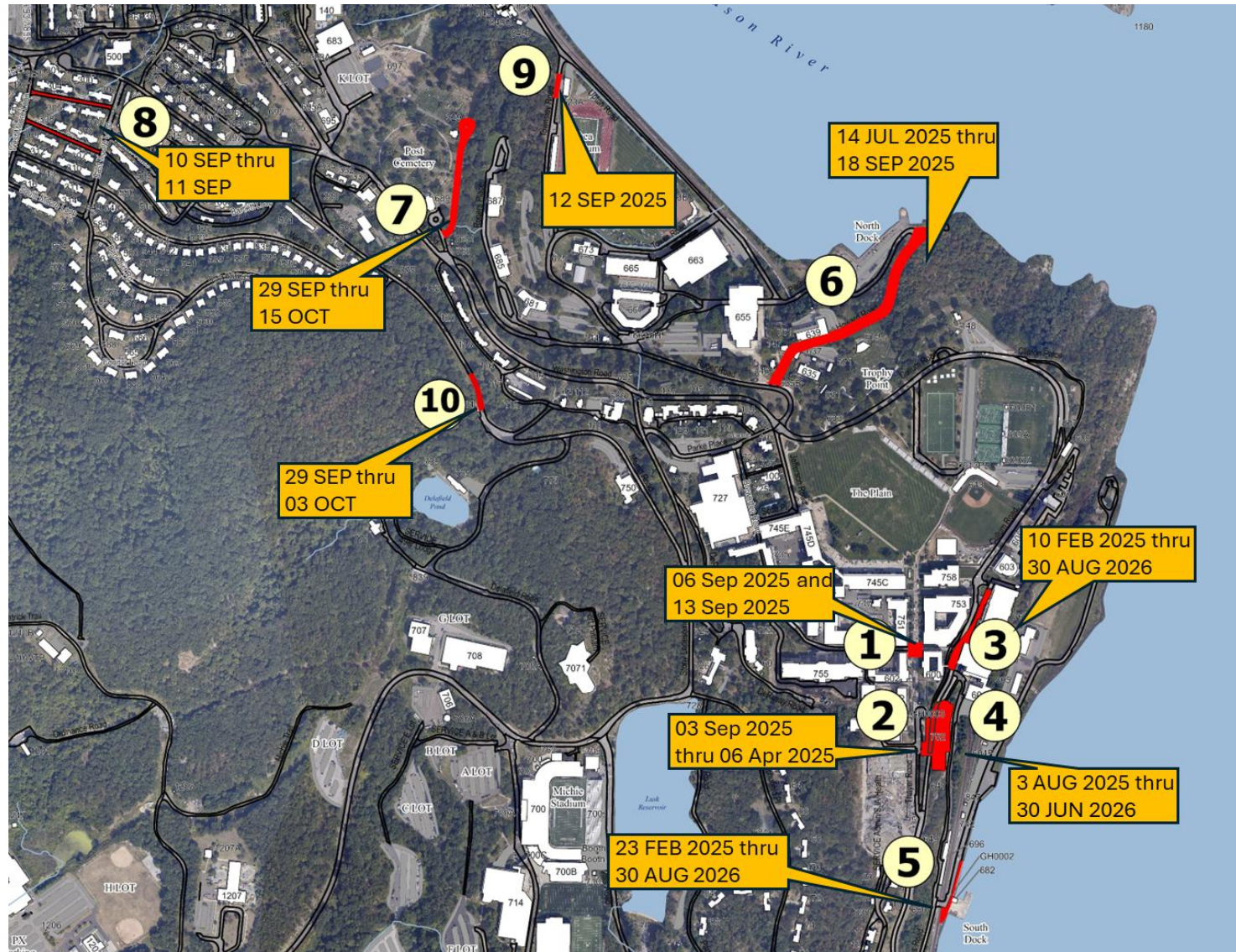

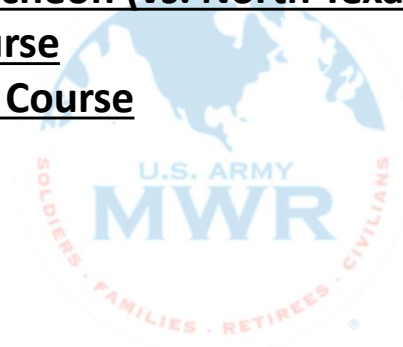

Tenant Bill of Rights

- Reside in a home that meets applicable health and environmental standards with working fixtures, appliances, and utilities.
- A written lease outlining rental terms to establish tenancy, including addendums and landlord-imposed rules on housing unit occupancy and common area use.
- Be provided multiple, convenient methods to communicate directly with the Landlord's maintenance staff.
- Access to an electronic work order system for tenants to request maintenance or repairs and track progress.
- Professional maintenance and repair with clear timeframes, including temporary relocation if needed until completion.
- Uniformed personnel may receive advice from Military Legal Assistance – (845)938-4541
- Dispute Resolution Process when all other methods have been exhausted.

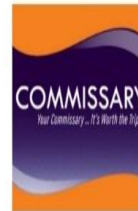

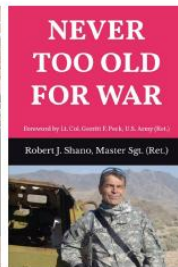

"Never Too Old For War" tells the incredible true story about an old Army four soldier named Bob Shano, a Vietnam-era veteran and a native-born New Yorker from the Bronx, who was compelled by the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks to return to the ranks. But what makes this book so unique is that Shano had previously served in the Army as an infantryman, left the military back in 1988 and, after being out of the service for 16 years, signed back up when he was 58 years old to serve alongside a new generation of infantry soldiers, ultimately completing three combat tours—two in Iraq and one in Afghanistan—before being honorably retired in June 2013 at age 62. Over the course of his eleven-year enlistment, Shano braved bullets, roadside bombs, rocket and mortar attacks, and some of the harshest environmental conditions on the planet as he served alongside his fellow infantrymen—most of whom were 18 years younger than he was. Actually, by all accounts, Bob Shano is the oldest person ever to serve in the Regular Army as an infantryman in a war zone. His motivation, wisdom, and transparent perspectives on military life, Army leadership, and the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan make his tell-all memoir a must-read for anyone interested in a brutally honest chronicle of military life and an authentic first-hand account of America's Global War on Terror.

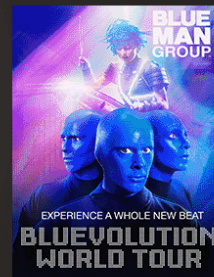

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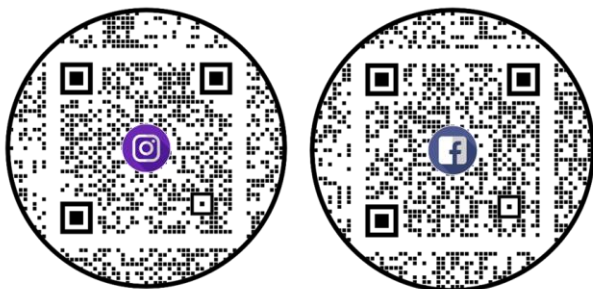
