


Speeding and Law Enforcement Trends (DES)

TRAFFIC: 2nd QTR FY25



Citations by Offender - SPEED (2nd QTR)




Citations by Offender - SPEED (April 2025)





May is Lyme Disease Awareness Month!



The Hudson Valley is a HIGH-risk area for tick encounters and Lyme disease.

Protect Yourself:



Know when you are in tick habitat and

Use an EPA-approved repellent such


as DEET, picaridin, IR3535, or oil of

lemon eucalyptus on skin. Use

permethrin on clothing.



Wear light-colored clothing that covers your arms and legs.



Perform tick checks after any outdoor activity. Take a shower after exposure to tick habitat to wash off any crawling ticks.



KACH Public Health participates in the DoD MilTICK program, which is a free testing and identification service available for ticks removed from DoD personnel and their dependents.

- Bring your collected ticks to the KACH Emergency Room, Primary Care, or West Point Public Health
- Ticks will be tested for Lyme disease, Rocky Mountain spotted fever, ehrlichiosis, anaplasmosis, babesiosis, and Powassan virus.

Moving Off Post

- Service members are required to give at least a 30-day notice. This gives BBC time to turn the homes for the inbound service members.
- After submitting notice, service members will schedule a pre-inspection and a final move out appointment.
- At the pre-inspection, the Customer Experience Specialist (CES) will go over any additional questions, concerns or charges that the resident may have.
