U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden Conducting Emergency Preparedness Exercise

Wiesbaden, Germany – The U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden will conduct an Emergency Preparedness exercise Feb. 23 – 27, in coordination with mission partners and German authorities. These exercises are a routine practice to ensure that the U.S. Army is prepared to respond to unexpected crisis.

"We appreciate the patience and support of our local community as we conduct this emergency preparedness exercise," said Garrison Commander Colonel Troy Danderson. "This training will test our ability to react to unforeseen, high-stress situations and is not a response to any specific threat. Our team is committed to conducting an effective emergency response training while minimizing disruptions to the local community."

As the exercise progresses, community members may notice changes at U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden installations, including heightened security measures, emergency responders on the installation, increased uniformed patrols in our military housing areas (such as Aukamm and Crestview) and other unusual activities related to simulated events on the installation.

All heightened security measures are being implemented in cooperation with our local German government and law enforcement partners.

These exercises are designed to be unexpected, which is why only limited details are announced in advance. In addition, as a matter of U.S. Army policy, specific security measures and operation time frames will not be publicly discussed.
