

**Welcome to the USAG Wiesbaden Vehicle Registration Office.**  
**Please ensure all mandatory documents listed below are present in hard copy form when conducting your transaction.**

**Register/ Transfer/ Renewal of a POV in Non-Operational Status:**

- ❖ Valid DOD ID Card (CAC or Privilege Card)
- ❖ Active Duty Members -copy of hard orders with assignment to Wiesbaden Germany. DOD Civilians - copy of hard orders with assignment to Wiesbaden Germany or memorandum from human resources verifying logistical support. **(If required)**
- ❖ Contractors - Must have physical SOFA Identification card (AE Form 190-1F) and passport for all transactions to verify status/support
- ❖ Completed Application for Motor Vehicle Registration (AE Form 190-1AA)
- ❖ Request to register, transfer, or renew a Nonoperational Vehicle Waiver form (AE Form 190-1AI) Approved by USAG Commander OR Director of Emergency Services Deputy Director
- ❖ USAREUR License Plates from Vehicle (unless renewing existing Nonoperational registration)
- ❖ Current USAREUR Registration ( AE Form 190-1A)
- ❖ \$45 Registration Fee (Credit/Debit Card, Check or Money order)

**Notes:**

- **Non-Operational Registration are valid for 90 days for Cars and 180 days for Motorcycles. If requested, a nonoperational Vehicle Waiver (AE Form 190-1AI) is required for extension not to exceed 1 year.**
- **Civilians or Service members residing off post must park the vehicle/motorcycle off post in a private parking area off public streets.**
- **Service Members living in On-Post Housing or Barracks may store the vehicle in the DFMWR Non-Operational vehicle lot. (USAG-Wiesbaden is not liable for vehicles damaged while stored in the Non-Operational Lot)**
- **The Non-Operational Lot will not be used to store vehicles while the Service Member is deployed.**
- **The sponsor must be present for the initial registration of a POV, regardless of who legally owns the vehicle. If the sponsor is not present, a spouse can register a vehicle if they have a General Power of Attorney or Special Power of Attorney from the legal office, authorizing the registering of a vehicle. Power of Attorneys (POA) are accepted from a SPOUSE ONLY.**
