He was assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters Company 2/72nd Armorer Battalion, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Casey, South Korea.

Command Sgt. Maj. Brown has served in all leadership positions including Unit Supply Sergeant, In-Processing Team Chief, Logistics Operations NCO, Iraq Forward (IZ-FWD) Battalion S4, Afghanistan Forward (AFG-FWD) Regiment S4, IZ-FWD Regiment S4, Battalion Support Operations NCOIC, Battalion S4 NCOIC, Joint Support Operations NCO, First Sergeant, Battalion Operations NCOIC, Battalion Operations Sergeant Major, Assistant Chief of Staff, G4 SGM and Battalion Command Sergeant Major.
