MEMORANDUM FOR all new members assigned in the Wiesbaden Military Community

SUBJECT: USAG Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter # 52, Discontinue JKO On-line Training and Testing for Europe POV Certificate of License

1. References:

- a. AE Regulation 190-1, Driver and Vehicle Requirements and the Installation Traffic Code for U.S. Forces in Germany, 11 Jan 2019.
- b. AE Pamphlet 190-34, Drivers Handbook and Examination Manual for Germany 16 Nov 10.
- c. External Standard Operating Procedures for Driver's Testing and Training Station (DTTS).

2. Purpose: To introduce change in methodology by which Wiesbaden-assigned personnel obtain their POV certificate of license.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all newly assigned personnel (Military, Civilian and Family Members) to the USAG Wiesbaden AOR. It implements a test approved by HQ USAREUR Office of the Provost Marshal (OPM) and has been coordinated with the U.S. Forces Registrar.

4. Effective Date: 1 July 2019 until rescinded in writing.


5. Details: USAG Wiesbaden's safety profile over the past year has shown an increase in vehicle accidents. The number is higher than the USAREUR average and is our highest source of risk for Soldiers, Civilians and Family Members. In response to this data and after evaluating options with the USAREUR OPM, the USAG Safety Office and the USAG PMO, the Garrison Commander decided to require all incoming newly assigned personnel to attend the training and complete testing at the USAG DTTS. Newly assigned personnel who have never been stationed in Germany before will receive POV license training and testing in person at the DTTS office during in-processing. Passing the written test is the requirement to receive a certificate of license to operate POVs in Germany after the initial in-processing period. It is intended to review the accident data after a 6 month period and decide if further action is needed.

6. Policy: All incoming and new personnel who have not obtained a USAREUR POV license in Germany before will attend the 2.5 hour "POV drivers orientation" class and pass the 100 question written test in order to obtain USAREUR POV Certificate of License.

7. DTTS schedule details: Monday morning is reserved for ITC scheduled Soldiers. The orientation and test can be taken on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays by appointment only. The orientations start at 0730 and end with the completed test at about 1200hrs.
