# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

- **United States Army in Europe Regulation (AER) 27-9, 22 November 2011, is the governing regulation for Army Affiliated Civilians.**
- **AER 27-9: Regulation applies to all civilian personnel (excluding active duty military), who receive individual logistical support (ILS) from the U.S. Military.**
- **The Civilian Misconduct Program:**
  - **Provides fair, meaningful and impartial adjudication of incidents pertaining to the misconduct of civilians.**
  - **Establishes administrative actions and procedures to be taken in response to civilian misconduct to safeguard the resources, facilities, and welfare of U.S. Forces communities in Europe.**



# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

- **USAREUR Commander is designated as the Civilian Misconduct Action Authority (CMAA) for USAREUR (Army).**
- **As the CMAA, the USAREUR Commander has the authority to remove all logistical support from anyone receiving it.**
- **This authority has been delegated to Garrison Commanders.**
- **All actions in response to Civilian Misconduct are taken by the Garrison Commander.**



# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

- **The USAG Wiesbaden Garrison Commander / CMAA acts as the Appellate Authority for all Army civilian personnel receiving ILS within the USAG Wiesbaden Footprint.**
- **Authority over: Contractors, Family Members, DOD Employees, DoDDS Employees, Diplomatic Staff, Retirees, and Local Nationals working for the military.**



# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

## JURISDICTION

- Host Nation has Exclusive Criminal Jurisdiction over civilians under the Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA).
- CMAA has Administrative Jurisdiction.
  - The CMAA can only take Administrative and Adverse Administrative Action, not punitive action.



# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

## Examples of CMAA Actions

1. Letter of Warning (LOW)
2. Letter of Intent (LOI)
3. Final Action Memo
4. Eviction from Quarters (to include Off-Based Rentals)
5. Mandatory referrals to Family Advocacy Program (FAP), Alcohol and Drug Counseling and referrals to other professional and social agencies:
  - Employee Assistance Program (EAP) Counseling
  - Adolescent Support and Counseling Services (ASACS)
6. Barment from all Garrison Areas of Responsibility
  - Local or Europe Wide
7. Early Return of Family Members/Dependents (EROD)
  - USAG Wiesbaden Directed
  - Organization Requested
  - Soldier/Sponsor Initiated
  - Curtailment of Tour
8. Request for Host Nation/German Prosecution
9. Community Service (Volunteer)
10. Ineligibility to participate in the Summer Hire Program (Teenagers)
11. Military Extraterritorial Jurisdiction Act (MEJA)



# USAG Wiesbaden

## Civilian Misconduct

### Examples of ILS

- **Commissary Privileges**
- **MWR Privileges**
- **POV and Driving Privileges**
- **Ration and Fuel Card Privileges**
- **Postal Privileges**
- **Exchange (AAFES) Services**
  
- **DoDDS Schools (DoDDS procedures must be followed)**
  - **Education is a right and cannot be suspended or revoked, BUT some education services can be addressed outside of a Military Installation as well (depending on the severity of an offense/action, i.e. Barment).**
  
- **Medical and Dental Services**
  - **Also a right that cannot be suspended or revoked, BUT some medical services can also be addressed outside of a Military Installation (depending on the severity of an offense/action, i.e. Barment)**



# USAG Wiesbaden Civilian Misconduct

CMAA, CMAS and Unit Leadership Relationships are Key to  
Ensuring a Strong Military Community

- The CMAA and CMAS rely on Unit Leadership to support an offender's adherence to CMAA Actions.
  - This may include, but is not limited to:
    - Ensuring Rehabilitation and Restitution Opportunities (R&RO) are complied with
    - Mandatory Counseling Attendance
    - Voluntary Community Service
    - Good Conduct Probation
    - Completing DA Form 4833 (Commander's Action Taken on Traffic Related Cases
    - Assistance with School related offenses
    - Barment and ERD actions
