MEMORANDUM FOR All Members of the United States Army Garrison (USAG)  
Wiesbaden Community

SUBJECT: USAG Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter #32, Cancellation of Religious  
Support Activities (RSA) Due to Inclement Weather

1. References:

2. Purpose: To apply weather calls and safety measures of the USAG Wiesbaden  
Inclement Weather SOP to specific USAG Wiesbaden Religious Support Operations  
(RSO). The RSO conducts evening and weekend activities for the Wiesbaden  
community and, during inclement weather, requires a mechanism of alerting the  
community of road conditions that will cancel services for safety purposes.

3. Applicability: This policy applies to all Military and Civilian personnel, including  
Family Members residing in the USAG Wiesbaden community.

4. Policy: USAG Wiesbaden's goal is to ensure the safety of those attending RSAs  
throughout the week and on weekends. When winter driving conditions present a  
hazard to evening and weekend services, those services will be cancelled.

a. USAG Wiesbaden Military Police desk monitors the 21<sup>51</sup> Weather Squadron  
forecast and warnings and assigns a color code of Green, Amber, Red or Black for road  
conditions.

(1) Sunday morning services will be cancelled if at two hours prior to the  
regularly scheduled service the road conditions are a Red or Black status.

(2) Evening RSA and services will be cancelled if the after school activities are  
cancelled and/or if road conditions at 1700 hours are at Red or Black status.

SUBJECT: US Army Garrison Wiesbaden Command Policy Letter #32, Cancellation of Religious Support Activities (RSA) due to Incliment Weather Policy

(3) Any other Religious Support Activities during the winter season will be cancelled if the road conditions are at a Red or Black status two hours prior to the event, regardless of the time of day or weekend.

b. The Wiesbaden Community can call the Wiesbaden Road Conditions Hotline at 0611-143-548-3040 at any time to hear the automated color coded road condition. 5. Each worshipping community will provide widest dissemination of this policy during the winter months to communicate the message and reduce risk.
