Mandatory COVID-19 Testing can take place free of charge for all Service Members, DoD Civilians, and their Family Members on Official Travel Orders (not leisure). **Individuals on Official Travel Orders can schedule appointments by contacting the Trace Teams directly at: 548-8990 (8991,8992,8993 - up to 8920).** 

If those needing a test due to Official Travel are unable to connect with the Trace Teams, they may test on the economy and be reimbursed on a later date.

Effective January 26, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will require all air passengers entering the United States (including U.S. citizens and Legal Permanent Residents) to present a negative COVID-19 test, taken within three calendar days of departure, or proof of recovery from the virus within the last 90 days. Airlines must confirm the negative test result or proof of recent recovery for all passengers prior to boarding. Airlines must deny boarding of passengers who do not provide documentation of a negative test or recovery.

This Order applies to all air passengers, 2 years of age or older, traveling into the US, including US citizens and legal permanent residents.
