Former traffic pattern: Aummanstrasse / Newman Village

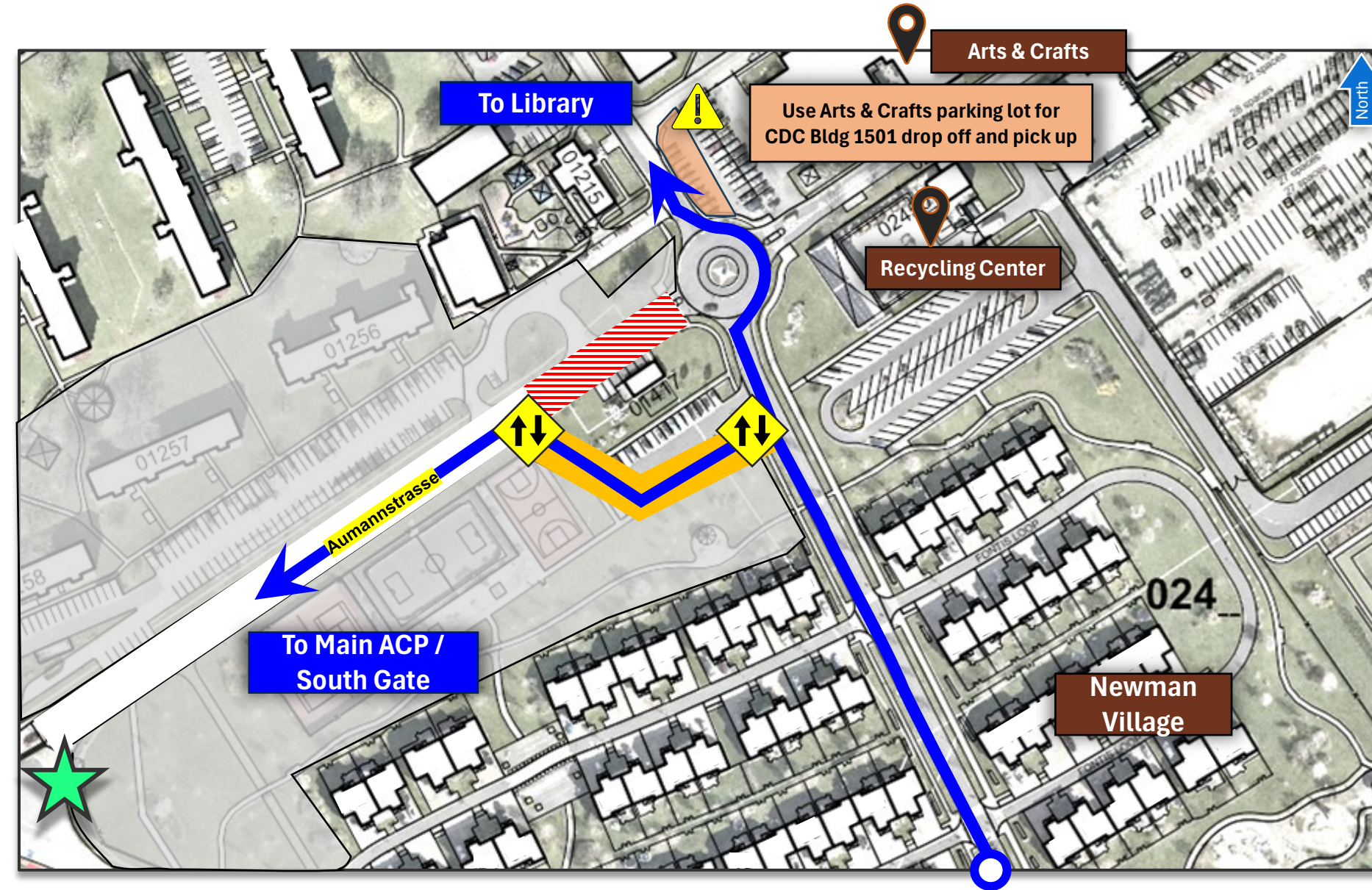

- Establish Clay Elementary School construction bubble

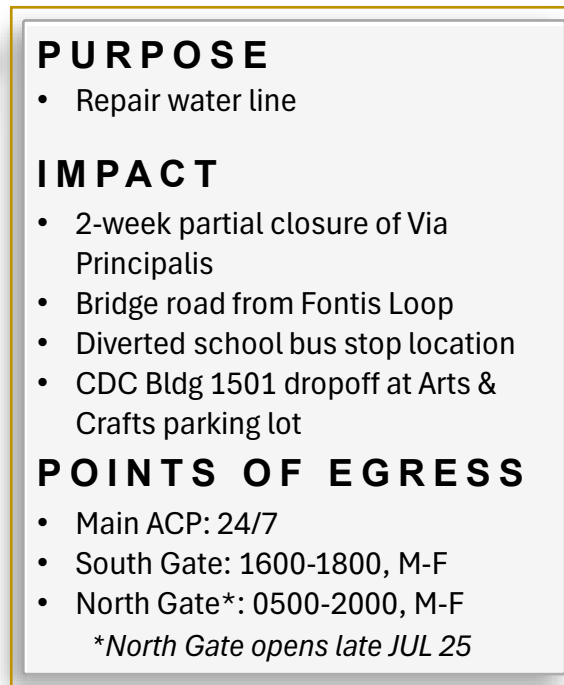
IMPACT
