Command Sergeant Major Yves Pamphil enlisted in the United States Army as a 92A, Automated Logistics Specialist, in August 2000. He completed Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, SC and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Lee, VA.

Command Sergeant Major Pamphil recently served as the Command Sergeant of the Headquarters and Headquarters Battalion of the 1st Infantry Division, Fort Riley, KS; CSM Pamphil served as the Support Operations SGM of the Division Sustainment Brigade of the 25th Infantry Division, Schofield Barracks, HI. CSM Pamphil was selected and assigned to 1st Capability Integration Group (A), Fort Belvoir VA where he served in multiple positions: HHC First Sergeant, Task Force J4 SGM, Supply Support Activity NCOIC, Central Issue Facility NCOIC, Assistant S4 SGM, Troop Supply NCO and NCOIC, and HHT Supply NCOIC. He served as the Supply Support Activity Clerk, Prescribed Load Listing Clerk, and the Army Maintenance Management System NCOIC for the U.S. Army John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center and School. He served as the Standard Army Maintenance System and Unit Level Logistics System-Ground NCOIC for 1st Battalion 10th Special Forces Group (Airborne).

While assigned to 1/10th SFG (A), Command Sergeant Major Pamphil deployed to Mali as a French Translator. Command Sergeant Major Pamphil has deployed in support of USAREUR-AF Assure, Deter, and Reinforce, Operation Enduring Freedom, and Operation Inherent Resolve.

Command Sergeant Major Pamphil completed all levels of Professional Military Education and is a graduate of the United States Sergeants Major Academy Course Class 70, Senior Leader's Course, Advanced Leader's Course, Basic Leaders Course, Jungle Operations Training Course, Military District of Washington Company Commander and First Sergeant Course, Battle Staff Course, Pathfinder Course, Jumpmaster Course, Airborne Course, Survival Escape Resistance and Evasion (SERE), and Master Resilience Training Course. Command Sergeant Major Pamphil's civilian education includes a Master of Science Degree in Accounting, a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Transportation and Logistics Management, and an associate degree in general studies.
