

# ARTEP to AMTP

## —do you know how to convert?

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The new generation training documents, which comprise the ARTEP Mission Training Plan (AMTP) will soon be in the field. These manuals, written for specific echelons within the TOE of the unit, allow training developers at the service schools to better focus their efforts to provide trainers with a much improved product.

One potential problem for trainers might be the identification of all the AMTPs applicable to the subordinate echelons within their TOE. It is important to remember that an AMTP may be applicable to all like echelons

even though the parent TOE is different. For example, the decontamination platoon of the 3-17J Decontamination Company and the decontamination platoon of the 3-387J Heavy Division Chemical Company use the same AMTP. The illustration at figure 1 further amplifies this conversion process.

The transition from the current ARTEP to the AMTP will take place over the next three to five years. The chart at figure 2 shows the transition as it will occur. To read the chart, look for the line that corresponds to your unit's TOE and read across.

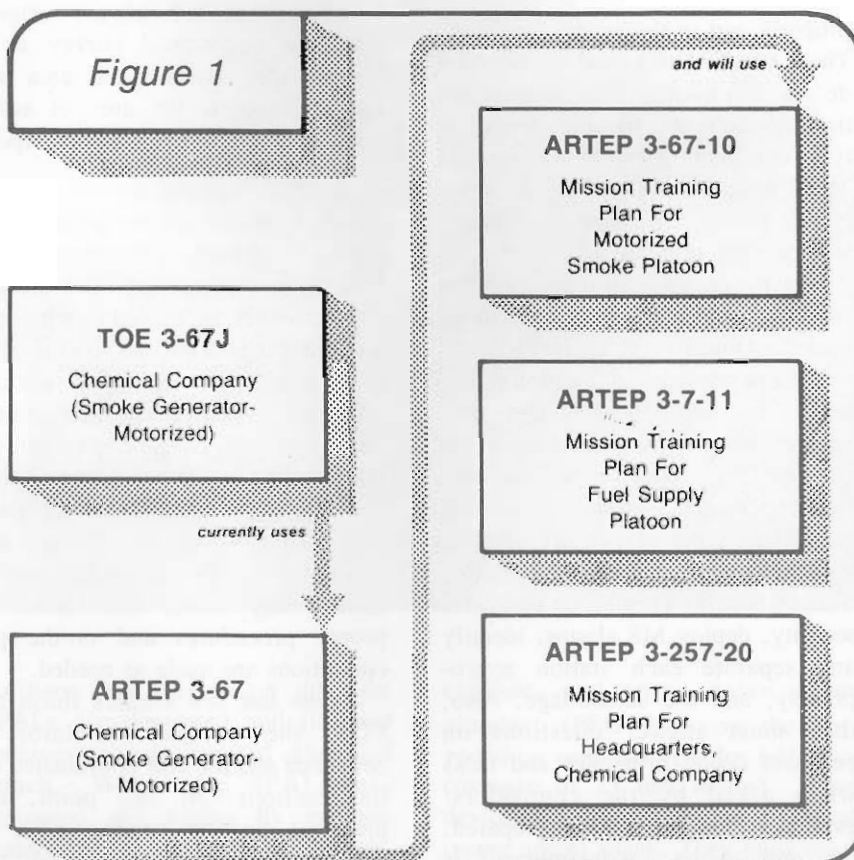
